Refresher on Functionality

- Available only to AOLS members and their staff/consultants
- Designed for, and limited to, research purposes only
- Data input by members remains the property of members with a license granted to other members and their staff for usage
- Although supporting spatial searches, tabular searches will be required for the foreseeable future as not all records are georeferenced
- Once firms/government agencies have set an administrator, they can manage their own users



Status

- PSRI is in production with most functionality complete
- Non-critical development/enhancements continue and will be implemented throughout the fall (e.g. automating administration, enhancing printing format, customizing sorting)
- The AOLS still has the opportunity to address issues, if required, over the next several months
- The Data Administrator RFP has been issued and closes in just less than 2 weeks – there focus will be on South-Central data for the first year
- This is the first of training sessions



Implementation

- Data has been imported from the South-Central Survey Records Index (SCSRI) and the PSRI is now active for South-Central
- The SCSRI is still active until the end of the month but will then be closed down (saving the AOLS the operational costs)
- New Data entry for South-Central should now be done in the PSRI
- Data has also been input for some firms outside of South-Central, particularly in the London Area



Implementation (continued)

- The PSRI is replacing the SCSRI and will be expected to be used completely as of November 1st
- The PSRI is open for use by all surveyors and their staff on a voluntary basis – It will become mandatory once the necessary regulation changes have been passed.



Training

- The PSRI offers a lot of functionality and some of its capabilities are not completely intuitive on first use – TRAINING IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED to take advantage of its capabilities
- This Webinar, like all those from the AOLS, will be available on-line for those that missed it
- Various Training manuals and presentations, along with built in help capabilities are available
- Training will also be offered to Regional Groups and/or groups of firms upon request - SC is set for October 25th
